



CUBING & CHARGEABLE WEIGHT RULES

Definitions

- Stackable: Can load beneath other freight
- Top-Loadable: Can load on top of other freight
- Non-stackable: Can not stack on top of or beneath other freight.
- Overlength: Single pallet or piece greater than 120 inches (10 feet) long

Cube Application

Cube is applicable as stated on each rate agreement. Kindersley Transports Standard cube is 10 lbs. per cubic foot calculated by multiplying the actual length by the actual width by the actual height of each handling unit in the shipment. Where a handling unit is 70" or taller, is unstackable or indicated as do not stack the height of the unit will be considered to be 96".

Exceptions

- Items 10 feet in length or longer are subject to an \$84.00 surcharge, **Items longer than 20 feet will not be accepted.**
- Handling unit length 60" or greater, Height will be 96"
- Handling Unit width 51" or greater & less than 60" in height, Height will be 96" width will be 50"
- Handling unit width 51" or greater & 50" inches in height or greater, height will be 96" width will be 96"
- If the top of the handling units is not level and able to be stacked on the height will be 96"

Linear Footage

Shipments of 5 or more handling units with a base of 40" by 48" or larger will be considered a minimum of 2' of trailer per handling unit for rating purposes. Shipments that occupy 10 linear feet of trailer are subject to a billable weight of 1000 lbs per linear foot.
